Place: Start and finish at the World Trade Center-New Orleans

Distance: 5K/3.1 mile

Directions for registration: Download this form to your computer, complete all required fields, and save it to your computer. Click the link for "PAYMENT" to link the PayPal site to pay your registration fee. Send your completed registration form to angela.bryan@colorado.edu. You will not be allowed to participate unless we have your registration form with the waiver checked.

Directions for race number/t-shirt pickup: Please pick up your race number and t-shirt at the SPSP 5K registration table on Thursday. The 5K registration table will be next to the SPSP registration table and will be open the same hours. We ask that you make every effort to pick up your number/t-shirt on THURSDAY rather than race day so that we can start the race on time.
